Best Case Scenario Rail Development Schedule -

The initial phase (Kapolei to Waipahu, approximately 6 miles in length and \$0.5 billion in cost) would be constructed as a fully locally funded section. While the initial phase moves quickly toward construction, the federal process would continue for the rest of the system (Waipahu to UH at Manoa) so that it would be eligible for federal funding.

Alternatives Analysis Draft EIS (AA/DEIS) Schedule:

An AA/DEIS is a single document that evaluates major transportation alternatives to assist the selection of the future system. AA/DEIS will be funded with the already secured federal funds (80%) and FY2006 City CIP (20%) for the total of \$10 million.
